#### BY THE NUMBERS

- **1,226** Number of players traded on deadline day since 1979-80. This excludes players involved in trades later invalidated by the NHL (one deal in 2022, one in 2009 and one in 1999).
- **674** Number of trades on deadline day since 1979-80. This excludes trades later invalidated by the NHL (one deal in 2022, one in 2009 and one in 1999).
- **481** Number of draft picks traded on deadline day since 1979-80. This excludes conditional picks where conditions were not met.
- **147** Number of players traded *multiple times* on deadline day, including 12 dealt *twice on the same date*.
- **70** Players acquired by the Penguins on deadline day since 1979-80, the highest such total of any franchise over that span. A full breakdown is included on page 9 of the attached PDF.
- **55** The highest number of different players dealt on a single deadline day, with 55 traded in 2010 and again in 2020. In 2020, deadline day trades involved 57 players but two were dealt twice: **Robin Lehner** (CHI to TOR, TOR to VGK) and **Martins Dzierkals** (TOR to CHI, CHI to VGK), who each landed in Vegas via Toronto and Chicago, respectively.
- **51** The number of different players traded on deadline day in 2022, including two dealt twice **Max Domi** (CBJ to FLA, then FLA to CAR) and **Tyler Inamoto** (FLA to CBJ, then CBJ to CAR) and excluding three involved in a trade later invalidated by the NHL.
- **41** Age of the oldest players traded on trade deadline day, of which there were two. **Mark Recchi**, acquired by the Bruins on March 4, 2009 (41 years, 31 days), and **Ron Francis**, acquired by the Maple Leafs on March 9, 2004 (41 years, 8 days).
- **40** Number of days prior to the scheduled completion of the regular season on which the NHL Trade Deadline occurs, as outlined in the Collective Bargaining Agreement (25 days in 2012-13; 26 days in 2020-21; 39 days in 2008-09, 2009-10, 2013-14 & 2016-17; 41 days in 2010-11). However, that number will stand at 42 days in 2022-23. From 1979-80 to 2003-04, the deadline was 26 days or fewer days prior to the scheduled completion of the regular season.
- **32** Number of trades on deadline day last season on March 21, 2022 (excluding the trade later invalidated by the NHL), tied for the most on a deadline day (also 32 in 2020).
- **28** Number of players since 1979-80 who have won the Stanley Cup after being acquired by a team on deadline day of that season, with **Artturi Lehkonen** and **Andrew Cogliano** the most recent to achieve the feat (COL in 2021-22). These players are denoted in the "Deadline Day Trades by Stanley Cup Champions" list below.
- **26** Number of first-round picks traded on deadline day over the previous 17 seasons (from 2005-06 to 2021-22), with at least one dealt in 14 of 17 years over that span. The most in one year over that span is five, in 2018. Check the chart on page 7 of the attached PDF.
- **26** Total number of draft picks traded in 2022 (excluding a conditional pick where conditions weren't met), tied for the most ever on a deadline day (also 26 in 2007).
- **26** Number of points **Marian Hossa** recorded with the Penguins during the 2008 Stanley Cup Playoffs (after being acquired from the Thrashers on deadline day in exchange for **Erik Christensen**, **Colby Armstrong**, **Angelo Esposito** and a first-round pick in the 2008 NHL Draft), the most ever in the playoffs by a player acquired at the trade deadline earlier that season.





- **18** Number of regular-season points by **Andrew Copp** (8-10—18 in 16 GP) with the Rangers in 2021-22 after being acquired from the Jets on deadline day, tops among all players dealt on March 21, 2022 and the most by any player acquired on deadline day since 2017-18 (**J.T. Miller**: 10-8—18 in 19 GP w/ TBL; acquired from NYR). More information on this topic is available on page 5 of the attached PDF.
- **18** Age of the youngest players to be dealt on deadline day since 1979-80: **Hudson Fasching** (18 years, 220 days in 2013-14; LAK to BUF), **Filip Forsberg** (18 years, 233 days in 2012-13; WSH to NSH), **Tyrone Garner** (18 years, 234 days in 1996-97; NYI to CGY), **Eric O'Dell** (18 years, 256 days in 2008-09; ANA to ATL) and **Michael Chaput** (18 years, 325 days in 2010-11; PHI to CBJ).
- **12** Number of players acquired by Winnipeg on deadline day over the past five years, the most among all clubs. A full team-by-team list is available on page 9 of the attached PDF.
- **10** Number of times that **Mike Sillinger** was traded in his career, the most in NHL history. His tally includes two deadline day deals: 2000 (TBL to FLA) and 2001 (FLA to OTT).
- 6 The most players involved in a single trade on deadline day since 1979-80. In 1991, the Blues traded **Geoff Courtnall**, **Robert Dirk**, **Sergio Momesso**, **Cliff Ronning** and future considerations to the Canucks for **Dan Quinn** and **Garth Butcher**. In 2013, the Blue Jackets traded **Derek Dorsett**, **Derick Brassard**, **John Moore** and their sixth-round pick in 2014 to the Rangers for **Marian Gaborik**, **Blake Parlett** and **Steven Delisle**. In 2022, the highest number of players involved in a two-team trade was four (in trades between DET & STL and ANA & PIT).
- 6 The most players acquired by one team on a single deadline day over the past five seasons (since 2017-18). The Jets added Kevin Hayes, Nathan Beaulieu, Alex Broadhurst, Bogdan Kiselevich, Matt Hendricks and Par Lindholm in 2018-19, and the Ducks added Danton Heinen, Sonny Milano, Kyle Criscuolo, Christian Djoos, Matt Irwin and Joel Persson in 2019-20.
- 6 Number of active general managers traded on deadline day since 1979-80: **Bill Guerin** (2009 & 2007), **Mike Grier** (2004), **Ron Francis** (2004), **Kevyn Adams** (2001), **Tom Fitzgerald** (1998) and **Jim Nill** (1982)
- **5** The most draft picks involved in a single trade on deadline day since 1979-80. A trade between the Stars and Kings on Deadline Day in 2007 saw five picks swapped: Dallas traded **Jaroslav Modry** and **Johan Fransson** along with its second- and third-round picks in 2007 and its first-round pick in 2008 to Los Angeles for **Mattias Norstrom**, **Konstantin Pushkarev** and the Kings' third- and fourth-round picks in 2007. <u>In 2022</u>, the highest such number was four in the **Andrew Copp** deal between the Rangers and Jets.
- **4** Number of active head coaches who were traded on deadline day since 1979-80: **Martin St. Louis** (2014), **Craig Berube** (1999), **Lindy Ruff** (1989) and **Dean Evason** (1985).
- 4 The highest number of players acquired on deadline day who wound up engraving their name on the Stanley Cup later that season. In 1993-94, the Rangers picked up five players on deadline day, including **Glenn**Anderson, Craig MacTavish, Stephane Matteau and Brian Noonan who were part of the championship roster.
- 2 Number of players acquired on 2022 deadline day who had their name engraved on the Stanley Cup as members of the champion Avalanche (**Andrew Cogliano & Artturi Lehkonen**) the highest such total since 1998 when **Jamie Macoun** and **Dmitri Mironov** got their names on the Cup after being acquired by Detroit.
- 1 Number of players acquired on deadline day since 1979-80 who have gone on to score the Stanley Cupclinching goal later that season, with **Artturi Lehkonen** becoming the first with Colorado (from MTL) in 2022.
- **0** Number of teams that have acquired a goaltender on deadline day since 1979-80 and had that goaltender earn the Stanley Cup-clinching victory later that season. Only three champions in that time frame have *acquired* a goaltender on deadline day: the 1981 Islanders (**Jari Kaarela**), 1988 Oilers (**Bill Ranford**; won Cup) and 2011 Bruins (**Anton Khudobin**).
